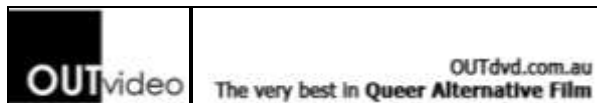
PFLAG Greater Shepparton meeting – Mon 6 Feb
