- To further promote and create awareness around the LDAT digital harm prevention resources developed in the first LDAT project to LGBTI communities and service providers across the Loddon Mallee region by December 2019.
- To engage members of the Bendigo LGBTI community in the design, delivery and implementation of a travelling AOD awareness ‘road show’ that can engage local communities and service providers across the Loddon Mallee region.
